There was an interesting question from the audience: "How do you incentivize failure?" We believe they meant: How can we incentivize an atmosphere of risk taking and innovation at the Army? In our opinion this is a quite reasonable question to ask when our first mission is to support the warfighter and lives are on the line. In our role as enterprise agile coach, we are often asked similar questions. We recommend things like: measuring the number of "spikes" (controlled, timeboxed experiments) that each team completes each month. It is shocking to me how many "agile" teams still to this day complete few or none of these.

Of course, it is not enough to incentivize risk taking, you also have to foster an environment of psychological safety in order to encourage people to take controlled risks such as: establishing blameless post mortems, performing root cause analysis and using the "five whys", and redesigning processes and applying automation to make a given failure much less likely or even impossible."
